This fan demo shows how this touch screen fan will work.

Press the Screen on the fan to start.



Off screen is displayed when device is not in use.

To turn ON click the slider circle.



This is the home screen.

Let us get started.

Click low button to set the fan speed to low.



Thats a little to low try Medium.

Click med button to set the fan speed to Medium.



Still not fast enough

Click high button to set the fan speed to high.



High is now selected.

Now let us turn on mist click the mist slider.



Now you are wet!

Turn off the mist by clicking the slider again.



Now that mist is off let us try setting the sleep mode.



This is where you set how much time till the fan goes to sleep / or turns off.

To set the time you would slide your finger along the dial.

In this case press the 25 in the middle to up the time.



Now that the time displays 30 minutes let us set it.


Click set.



Now the sleep slider shows that it is in the set postion or on.

Next let us set custom fan rotation.

Click the custom button.



This is were you set the rotation by pitching the area on the screen.

But in this case there is a 180° preset button back on the home screen.

Press the back button.



Now that you are back

Press the 180° button located left of the custom button.

The rotation will stop if you go in to one of the menus so that it is easer to make selections



Now we have the rotation set for 180°.

Let us change the temperature it is a little too warm.

Press temp

The icons will shift and morph to display the temperature screen.




To change the temperature you would be able to slide your finger along the thermostat or use the plus and minus buttons.

Change the 72° to 70° by clicking the minus button twice.



One more click.



Now that you are at 70° press set.



Next let us take a look at the settings.

Press the gear in the upper left corner.



This is the settings page.
On the actual screen you would be able to scroll through the time and set it.

The other settings are a power savings mode which helps to conserve energy. And a way to make it controlled from an app on your phone.

Click power saving slider



Good

Now click save



Let us check what the help page looks like.

Press the ? button in upper left corner



The help page will have little mini video tutorials to introduce you to the device.

Let us go to the home page press the back button



Try out the lock screen

This will lock your settings and help conserve power.

Click the lock button which would be a press and hold.



Lock screen slides in from left.

This is the lock screen it displays the settings previously selected you cannot change them until you unlock the device.

Unlock the device click the slider circle.



These are good settings let us make it a favorite.

Click the plus sign button next to the star.

This will morph into the favorites page.




Here is the favorites page.

Lets name it "cool"

Type c



Type o



Type o again



Type I



Press Enter



Ok looks good now lets delete something, how about Jacobs Fan.

Click the Minus – sign next to Jacobs Fan



All set go back to the home page.

Press back.



Now the name cool appears just below and to the right of the 70°.

Ok time to turn the fan off, don't want to get to cold.

Press the off slider circle.

Press the on slider circle.
